

# DRESS & CONDUCT POLICY

The Wangaratta RSL Sub Branch Inc aspires to promote an experience of the highest standard, inclusive of all.

In keeping with the traditions and customs of our history, members and guest are expected to conduct and attire themselves respectful of our heritage. Guidance on such follows.

## DRESS

**Attire must be clean, neat, tidy, in good repair and in good taste without exception.**

**The following examples do NOT meet these expectations at any time:**

**Dirty or in disrepair footwear and/or clothing.**

**Bare feet**

**Headwear (Themed events excepted)**

**Swimwear**

**Provocative/offensive/political motifs or logos.**

**Sleeveless shirts or singlets (appropriate fashion items excepted)**

**Club colours or emblems (Vietnam Veterans MC and Digger MC Clubs excepted)**

**Hygiene, or lack of, that effects the quiet enjoyment of other patrons.**

## CONDUCT

The conduct of all patrons must allow for the quiet enjoyment of the amenity of the Wangaratta RSL without discomfort to all. It is a condition of continued visitation to Wangaratta RSL that your conduct be orderly, non-offensive, nor of a disruptive manner.

**Provocative or offensive language, gestures or actions will not be tolerated at any time.**

### NOTICE

Management reserves the right to decide, and has absolute discretion, to exclude patrons whose attire or conduct is NOT in keeping with the traditions, customs and heritage of the Wangaratta RSL, in keeping with the guidance above, and will be therefore final.
