5.2 Acknowledgement of Country.

At the May 2021 meeting the Executive put together the following passage for consideration by the Committee.

The Wangaratta RSL acknowledges that this ceremony of observance occurs on the lands of First Nation Peoples and we acknowledge their significant and enduring connection to Country and on this day in particular, we also remember those First Nation peoples who laid down their lives in times of war to protect our country.

This was adopted by the Committee on the 20th May 2021.

Remembrance Day 2021 was the first time that the acknowledgement was to be used but in reconsideration it was deemed to replace the word "protect" with "defend".

Recommendation: that the Committee endorse the change in the acknowledgement to read:

The Wangaratta RSL acknowledges that this ceremony of observance occurs on the lands of First Nation Peoples, and we acknowledge their significant and enduring connection to Country. Today in particular, we remember those First Nation peoples who have laid down their lives in times of war to defend our nation.
