'I would like to acknowledge that this ceremony of observance, and all observance ceremonies in Victoria, occur on the lands of First Nation Peoples and we acknowledge their significant and enduring connection to Country and pay our respects to their Elders past, present and emerging'.

At the ordinary meeting of members held earlier today, the President sought feedback from those in attendance regarding the introduction of an acknowledgement to country at future commemoration services. Overall feedback was that we should consider with the focus being on those indigenous Australians that gave the ultimate sacrifice during times of war.

The Executive put together the following passage for consideration by the Committee.

The Wangaratta RSL acknowledges that this ceremony of observance occurs on the lands of First Nation Peoples and we acknowledge their significant and enduring connection to Country and on this day in particular, we also remember those First Nation peoples who laid down their lives in times of war to protect our country.
